(c) *Ensure that every adult you designate is registered with the Troop in advance of designation.* **Note:** If you have declined the General Designation and no person designated above is present, or is able or willing to provide transportation for any reason, then your Scout may be left with NO transportation option through the Troop and you will need to provide other transportation promptly. Your Scout may be denied participation in future Troop events if the Troop is inconvenienced by more than 15 minutes on any occasion. Deposits and payments are not refundable simply because transportation is unavailable or delayed.
